

PRESENTATION


The **5th edition of Movie Score Malaga (MOSMA)**, an international audiovisual music festival organized by the **Festival de Málaga** and **Malaga City Council**, will take place from **September 10th to 12th** in an edition fully adapted to the current health & safety circumstances. Due to the coronavirus pandemic, MOSMA is filling the program this year with concerts, all of which will have limited entry with all the standard health, safety and hygiene protocols in place.

MOSMA is an event dedicated to audiovisual music, an artistic discipline that is part of our daily lives through series, video games and, of course, on the big screen in feature films. It seeks to be an international meeting point for well known composers as well as for upcoming new talent.
